



## Advice and support for people experiencing sight loss.

Eye Clinic Liaison Officers (ECLOs) assist anyone with sight loss, their relatives and carers, to access the support they may need, when they need it.



## Based in hospitals, Eye Clinic Liaison Officers (ECLOs) provide:

- emotional support, information and advice on living with sight loss and maintaining independence
- details of the latest aids and equipment
- advice on benefits and concessions
- information relating to eye conditions and registration
- advice about education, employment, housing and leisure.

"When my sight began to deteriorate, I didn't want to accept it, I was embarrassed. I was a mother and wife and very independent.

"But then I was referred to an Action for Blind People ECLO which was such a lifeline to me. They helped me to get a magnifier so I can check bus timetables without having to ask for anyone's help. I recently went to Scotland on my own, no husband and no kids! I feel so much better and I owe so much to Action's ECLO service."
