What does the LOC do?

The LOC represents the interests of its optometrists, dispensing opticians and pre-regs and acts as local interface with the NHS, and all other health related organisations and providers who wish to deal collectively with its members.

Currently

The LOC currently informs, advises and negotiates with the CCG's, NHS Shropshire and Local Area Team. It is represented at the Local Health Economy Ophthalmology (LHE) Group by LOC Chair Paul D Cottrell and has been developing community eye care schemes across the region for the last few years.

Can I attend meetings of the LOC?

All optometrists, dispensing opticians and pre-reg students working in Shrophire are welcome to attend LOC meetings as observers.
