- Following a recent communication from LOCSU, please can we request that contractors let
 us, the LOC, know about any closures or adaption of hours, together with your contact
 details which may be a personal email or contact if you are going to be out of practice. It
 may be that you are closing but wanting to get involved in emergency care should a national
 solution come about. With this in mind, we will collate a list of locums who are willing and
 able to work across practices during the COVID crisis in response to changes in workforce.
- If any contractor is closing, partially closing or adapting their hours, they need to contact their local NHS England office to let them know the new arrangement. Details to include:
 - o Contractor name (include name of directors if corporate body)
 - Practice name and full address ODS code (this can be found on the ODS portal https://odsportal.hscic.gov.uk/Organisation/Search)
 - Effective date of closure or change in opening hours
