

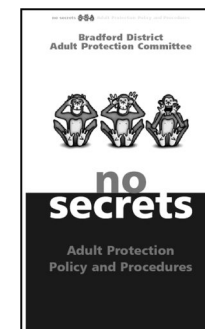
Guidance for who to contact for support and advice relating to Adult Protection

People covered by Adult Protection include: disabled adults, frail elderly, those with learning disabilities, mental health issues, and carers

Signs and Symptoms of Adult Abuse

(Adapted from Bradford District Adult Protection Committee - No Secrets Adult Protection Policy and Procedures)

Physical -	hitting, slapping, pushing, kicking, misuse of medication, restraint or inappropriate sanctions
Sexual -	rape, sexual assault, sexual innuendos, sexual activity or viewing sexually explicit materials where the person has not given consent
Emotional -	threats of harm or abandonment, isolation, deprivation of contact, humiliation, blaming, controlling, intimidation, coercion.
Financial or Material -	theft, fraud, exploitation, pressure regarding: wills / property / inheritance / financial transactions, misuse or misappropriation of property, possession or benefits
Neglect / Acts of Omission -	ignoring medical or physical care needs, failure to provide access to appropriate health, social care or educational services, withholding the necessities of life such as medication, adequate nutrition and heating
Discriminatory -	racist, sexist, homophobic or based on disability or age or other forms of harassment, slurs or similar treatment



What should I do if I have concerns about an Adult who may be being abused?

Adult Protection can be very complex. If at any time you require advice please contact the Adult Protection Unit on Tel; 01274 431077

Practitioner has concerns

- Ensure immediate safety / medical attention
- Summon the emergency services if needed
- If a crime has just occurred call the police
- Preserve the evidence
- Record

Make a time for the person to be seen again by someone from the practice if appropriate
